

Car Accident?

*Secrets your insurance company
may not want you to know.*

Mt. Laurel, NJ According to scientific studies, individuals who are involved in motor vehicle accidents have an increased likelihood of developing conditions (such as arthritis) later in life. An individual who has suffered even a minor accident (5 mph) may be up to six times more likely to develop arthritis. In a study published in the medical journal *Injury*, the authors found that 86% of those individuals involved in motor vehicle accidents still had symptoms 10 years later.

In another study published in *Neurology*, the scientific journal of the American Academy of Neurology, a test of neck movement was used to predict which people with whiplash injuries will be disabled a year later. To often individuals involved in an accident feel no pain for a week or two or even a month after the accident. This will lead people to settle a claim early on, only to find out 2 months later they have suffered a very serious injury and could have received a larger settlement.
